MBTA to Boston College



From Logan Airport, there are two main routes to get to Boston College by public transportation (the 'T'). The first is usually faster but costs \$2.40; the second is free but usually slower, especially with the on-going construction:

- 1. Take the shuttle bus to the Airport T station. There are different routes (22, 33, & 55) depending on the terminal that will take you (ask the driver if you are unsure). Take the Blue Line (\$2.40) Westbound (toward Bowdoin) 3 stops, exit at Government Center station. Transfer to the Green Line, Westbound, **B Line**, follow directions below.
- 2. Take the Silver Line to South Station (free). Transfer to the Red Line Northbound (toward Alewife). Go 2 stops and exit at Park Street. Transfer to the Green Line, Westbound, **B Line**, follow directions below.

Take the MBTA Green Line – <u>B line</u> toward Boston College. Exit at the last stop. Cross the street (Commonwealth Ave.) to Fr. Herlihy Drive (St. Ignatius Church is on the corner of Comm. Ave. & Fr. Herlihy Drive). Turn right onto Campanella Way.

To get to the dorm registration (Stayer Hall) and the dormitory (Ignacio Hall): Stayer Hall is on the left side of the BC entrance on Campanella Way. The building entrance is off the parking lot adjacent to Stayer. After getting your room assignment, follow Campanella Way about 850 ft (300 m). Turn up the driveway just past the bus stop. Ignacio Hall, is the first building in front of you.



To get to Higgins Hall (the conference venue):

Follow Campanella Way around the curve to the parking garage. Take the elevator to the top floor. Walk across to the other side (~west). You can also take the stairs up the outside of the garage. Turn left and follow the path past the O'Neill Library (~south). Turn left to go around Devlin Hall. Follow the path around to the right to the front of Higgins.
