Summer 2024 Residency Agreement

This document, when signed below by you and accepted by Boston College (the “University”) upon it making a room assignment, shall constitute the agreement between you and the University pertaining to your residency in University housing during the Summer 2024 term. The University agrees to provide you with the use of the room assigned to you on the terms and conditions outlined in the *Conditions for Residency* and all other information posted on the Office of Residential Life’s [website](#). The term Conditions for Residency, as used in this agreement, shall refer to the 2024-2025 Conditions for Residency promulgated by the Boston College Office of Residential Life, as such may be revised pursuant to this agreement. The Conditions for Residency is posted on the Boston College Residential Life [website](#). Hard copies of the Conditions for Residency may be obtained by visiting the Office of Residential Life (Maloney Hall, Suite 413).

In addition to, and notwithstanding anything contrary contained in, the Conditions for Residency, you agree that the following provisions shall apply to your residency in University housing.

Change of Assignment: In the event you transfer to a room different from that originally assigned, the terms and conditions of this agreement will remain in full effect without the execution of a new agreement.

Agreement Period: The term of your residency under this agreement shall commence upon check-in and shall end on the check-out date established by the University.

Residential Meal Plan Contract: Subscription to the University meal plan is not required of summer students or summer student workers. Dining Service information and options may be viewed and selected via the Dining Services [website](#).

Termination of Residency by the University: The University may terminate this agreement and your residency in University housing in the event of any material or persistent disregard by you of any of the rules and regulations set forth in the Conditions for Residency or as otherwise provided in the Conditions for Residency or in accordance with other University policy.

Modifications to the Conditions for Residency: The University reserves the right to revise and amend the rules and regulations set forth in the Conditions for Residency at any time during the year.

Student Rights and Responsibilities: The [Conditions for Residency](#) are based on the principles of self and mutual respect whereby the rights and responsibilities of the students and the University are defined. In addition to the terms above, you understand that during this period:

- You understand that you are not permitted to have any guests under the age of 18 years old on-campus unless they are accompanied by their parent/guardian in accordance with the University’s [Protection of Minors Policy](#).
- You will be charged for summer housing on a per night basis at the end of each summer session. Failure to check-in/-out properly may result in additional nightly charges being assessed to your student account.
- You must be cooperative with Community Assistants and all other University staff.
- Due to the required facilities maintenance work, University staff may need to access your room throughout the summer with no or little advance notice.

Summer Alcohol and Drug Policy: Students are expected to abide by the alcohol and drug policies set forth in the [Conditions for Residency](#) and the [Student Code of Conduct](#) at all times. In addition, and notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth therein, during the summer months, residential students must also comply with these additional requirements:

- **NO** alcohol is permitted within residence halls, **regardless of age**.
- Students must not be in the presence of or under the influence of alcohol or drugs while on-campus, including in the residence halls, **regardless of age**; students must not be under the influence of marijuana or illicit drugs on- or off-campus.
- These additional requirements apply to all guests.
- **You understand that violating any of these policies may result in immediate removal from my summer housing and summer employment.**

- In the event of any conflict between this Summer Alcohol and Drug Policy and the alcohol and drug policies set forth in the Conditions for Residency and the Student Code of Conduct, this Summer Alcohol and Drug Policy shall prevail.
