The minor includes 2 required courses (6 credits) and 4 courses (12 credits) that must be selected from the list of approved courses provided below.

Note: Applied Psychology and Human Development majors must earn 18 credits and must choose different APSY courses than their focus electives. Only one course (3 credits) may be shared between the major and minor.
