



How Do I Find my Legacy Protocol?

- Protocols originally approved in CyberIRB are called **legacy protocols**
- To find your legacy protocols, click “Locate My Records” or enter the protocol # into “Quick Find,” both located within the top ribbon of the webpage, .
- Click the Protocol # and select View -> Master Record

How Does My Legacy Protocol Look in InfoEd?

- Your legacy protocol data will not be fully populated into the InfoEd eform (e.g. research summary will not be populated into the eform), but research personnel, study title, and protocol number will be populated.
- Your full legacy protocol (initial and any amendments) will appear as PDFs in the Attachments section of the master record for that protocol.
- You can see all application PDFs under “Attachments” and “Submissions” -> Initial Application
